LRA Cllrs Leon Girling, David Wixley, Howard Kauffman and Chris Pond recently fought at a District Council meeting to retain the field, much-valued by local residents, for educational use. Council tax 2016-17. We currently expect the following:

- Loughton Town Council (LRA-led): no increase
- **Epping Forest District Council:** no increase
- Essex County Council: increase of 3.99% (the maximum possible without a referendum), which is £43 for a Band D property
- Police & Fire Services: not yet known, but we expect an increase in the Police precept.

**Note**: out of every £1 of Council Tax, the County Council gets 72p, the District Council gets 10p, the Police 10p and the Fire Service and the Town Council 4p each.

### **Debden Station car-park.**

"Dropping-off". A resident complained that she had been charged for parking when all she had done was to drive round the car-park to drop off a friend, and had then left. There are now automatic cameras operating. NCP say that there is a 15 minute grace period during which customers who enter and leave are not required to pay. [EFNW]

We are pleased that the District Council has decided that such a scheme would not be viable – LRA's concern would be that any resulting increase in usage of the Central Line would adversely affect Loughton commuters using Debden & Loughton stations, as use of the Line is already at or over capacity.

- **Council housing.** The Council's total anticipated expenditure on the housebuilding programme over the next 4 years is £40.3m. As part of this, they will undertake feasibility studies at 13 sites across Loughton (listed in the second weblink below), for 40 new affordable homes (bungalows, houses and flats), to be built by November 2018. 
