Sharon (District & Town Cllr) spends a lot of time dealing with residents' problems. Since last May she has been Town Mayor. She has represented the Town on many occasions and has chaired all the "full Council" meetings. Her job sometimes takes her away from Loughton, so other LRA Cllrs have covered any District Council meetings that she couldn't get to.



Parking west of the High Road. County Cllrs Chris Pond (LRA, Loughton Central) & Valerie Metcalfe (Cons, Loughton South & BH) have submitted proposals for a Residents Parking Zone (RPZ) covering:

Forest Road	Clifton Road	High Beech Road	
Smarts Lane	Shaftesbury	Staples Road	The Drive and streets off.

The more distant streets have been included to avoid them being deluged by displacement parking, which will be considerable. This is only the first stage of a very long process, which will involve getting residents' views before anything happens. We will keep you informed.

Potholes & other Highways matters

High Road street-lights. 8 or 9 months ago new lamp standards were erected next to the existing posts in the High Road (between Algers Road & The Crescent) but have never been connected - we have tackled the County Highways portfolio-holder about these delays, which are the fault of the power company (UK Power Networks Ltd).



Upper Park / Lower Park Road: despite continuing pressure from LRA Cllr Jill Angold-Stephens, a year after a serious accident County Highways have still not replaced the missing warning signs – we'll keep reminding them. However, we're told that some form of surfacing work will soon be carried out.

Planning issues.

The LRA Plans Group (LPG) looks at all planning & licensing applications in Loughton, and takes action where necessary. For two contentious applications, at 20 Ollards Grove and 20 Albion Hill, we delivered letters to nearby residents telling them what was happening and how they could comment to the District Council, which eventually turned down both applications (more in our *Loughton Life* newsletter).

Subsequently LRA Cllrs have raised the poor state of 20 Ollards Grove with the District Council, who asked the owner to clear it up, or the Council would take formal steps.

Crime in Loughton

- **Problems in Algers Road area.** A resident has reported problems of overnight car damage. If some-one damages your car please let the police know so that they know where to focus their efforts.
- **suspicious behaviour anywhere.** If you see anyone behaving suspiciously, let the Essex Police Control Centre (not Loughton police station) know – 999 for emergencies or 101.
